ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

Examples in action:

1. When training around the UK, trainers are selected based upon their closeness to client sites. This helps in reducing unnecessary carbon emissions and in turn use less fossil fuel.
2. Car engine ECU re-mapping to produce fuel economy improvements.
3. Wherever possible we will do business by email, telephone and video conferencing in order to reduce any unnecessary travel.
4. Local suppliers will be used, wherever possible, to help reduce the carbon footprint.
5. All paper and printer cartridges are recycled.
6. All paper purchased must be of "recycled" type.
7. Where possible all communications and documents will be kept electronically to reduce the reliance on printed materials.
8. We use energy efficient light bulbs at all times.
